





Wild Grass Nature Resort is a luxury boutique hotel set in 25 acres of forest land, surrounded by a stunning vista of lush forestry, mountains, and a lake. The resort limits itself to 8 villas (12 rooms in all) on the entire property, adequately spaced out to make privacy the ultimate luxury. The resort is visited by various animals, including elephants, wild boar, deer, wild rabbits, peacocks, and more than 40 varieties of birds.

Location

Wild Grass Nature Resort is located in the cultural triangle of Sri Lanka, which is a must-see for every traveller. It is in a little village called Kumbukkadanwala, between Sigiriya (9 km) and Dambulla (15 km), home to two UNESCO heritage sites. Other heritage locations easily accessible from Wild Grass are Polonnaruwa, Anuradhapura, and Kandy, making the resort an ideal base for extended stays. Further afield, guests can use Wild Grass as the starting point to travel to Trincomalee, Batticaloa, Jaffna, and Kalpitiya. The resort is 144 km (approximately 4 hours) from the Colombo International Airport.



Our Villas


Our ultra-spacious villas are built with minimum brickwork and maximum glass, allowing you expansive views of the natural surroundings.




Villa size: minimum 100 sq m. (1070 sq ft). Villas have a living room, bedroom, bathroom, balcony or outdoor sitting area, and garden.
